

English Words of Arabic Origin

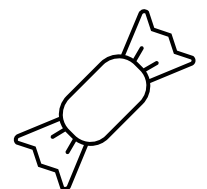
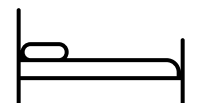
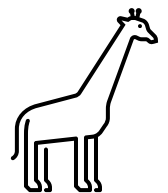
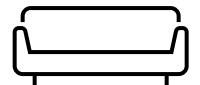
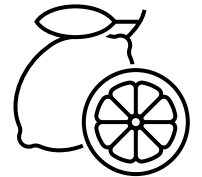
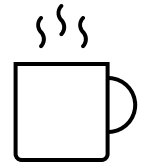
